## COVID-19 | Working at Site

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, WorkSafe BC requires that *Physical Distancing* is maintained on jobs sites to prevent spread of infection. *Physical Distancing* means not being within 2 metres (6.5 feet) of other workers. If *Physical Distancing* is not possible while doing work tasks, see the SWP COVID-19 | Working Under 6.5' Apart

### 1. Hand Washing

- Upon arrival at site before work
- Before and after lunch
- Before leaving site at the end of your shift
- Before and after smoking
  - Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. When soap and running water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand rub with at least 60% alcohol.
  - Always wash hands that are visibly soiled.
  - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with bare or gloved hands. If you do have to touch your face, wash hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water before and after.

### 2. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

All workers who cannot maintain physical distance (2 meters, 6.5 ft) should refer to the SWP COVID-19 | Working Under 6.5' Apart

- Safety glasses
- Gloves
- For extra protection disposable nitrile gloves may be added under work gloves or used when not wearing work gloves when available
- Workers must be trained on the following:
  - How to properly put on, use, and take off PPE
  - how to properly dispose of or disinfect PPE
  - how to inspect PPE for damage and how to maintain in good working order
  - the limitations of PPE

### 3. Cleaning/Disinfecting

- When task is completed, ensure the tools that were used are cleaned and disinfected

## COVID-19 | Working at Site – 2

- Clean and disinfect all high-touch surfaces in the area such as:
  - Shared equipment and tools
  - Tables and chairs
  - Counters
  - Microwaves/ coffee makers/ water coolers
  - Doorknobs/ handles
  - Printers, computers, tablets
  - Etc.

### 4. Health Checks

All workers will be screened by the foreman or designated COVID monitor upon arrival at work and their health monitored throughout the day

1. Has anyone NOT washed/sanitized their hands coming onto site?
2. Has anyone been in direct contact with a known COVID case?
3. Has anyone or someone in their household travelled anywhere outside Canada in the last 14 days?
4. Has anyone been told to self-isolate or quarantine by a healthcare professional?
5. Does anyone have any of the following symptoms - Fever, dry cough, sore throat, runny nose or recent trouble breathing
6. Is anyone NOT fit for work and symptom free?
7. Is anyone working in an area or has a task that prevents social distancing? (i.e. heavy pipe)
  - If work to be done within the 6.5' required distancing, measures outlined in the *COVID-19 | Working Under 6.5' Apart* SWP will be followed

### 5. Clothing

- Do not leave clothes in lockup at the end of the day
- Take work clothes home
- Washing work clothes each day to disinfect is recommended
- Don't wear work clothing into your home whenever possible
